- **DO NOT** pull this product, only push to prevent personal injury.
- **DO NOT** alter this product by welding on an attachment or adding electrical equipment. Do not mount this product on a moving object or vehicle.
- **DO NOT** stand on top of unit as this may cause the product to tip.
- **DO NOT** overload the trolley. Maximum product weight (including contents) should not exceed 135kg (300lb). Ensure the weight is evenly distributed.
- **DO NOT** use the product on uneven surfaces or inclines as this may cause the product to tip or become unstable resulting in possible personal injury or product damage.



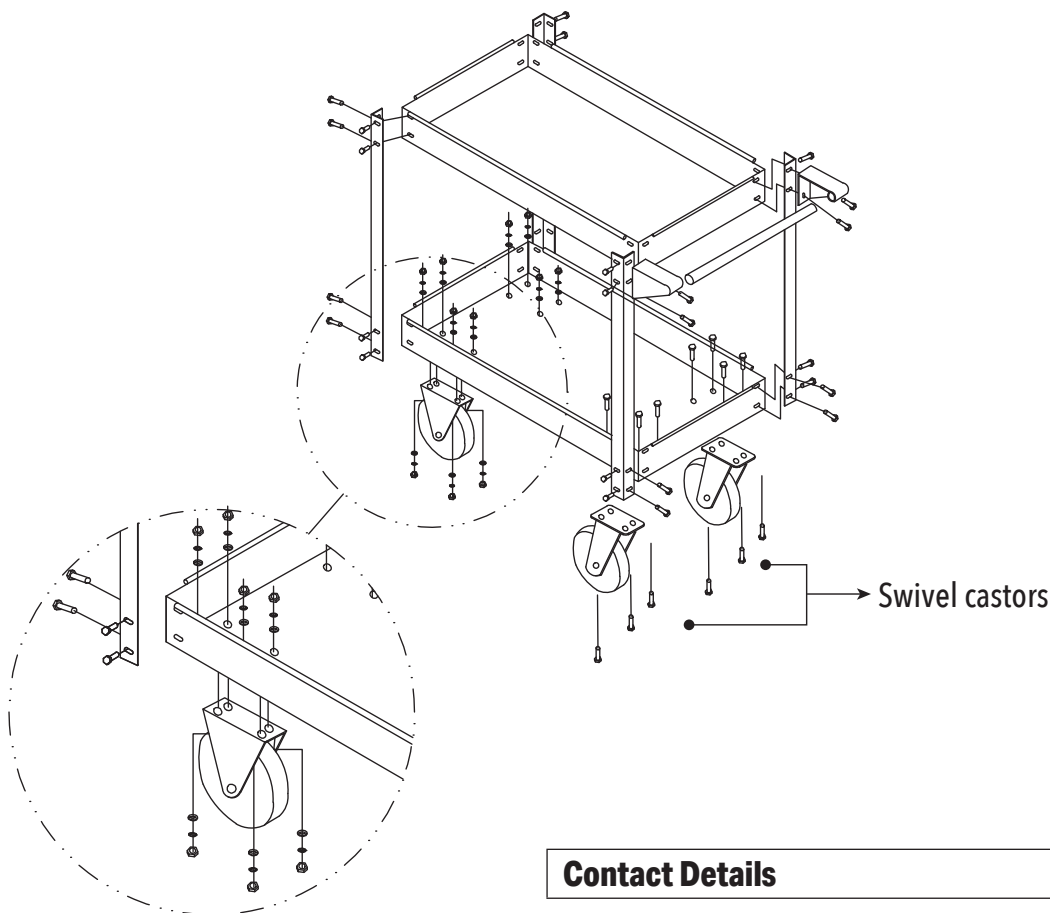
- Check that the trolley is correctly assembled before adding contents.
- **DO NOT** use trolley if any parts are damaged, especially the castors.

## Assembly

**Unpacking:** Carefully remove the product from the packaging and examine it for any signs of damage that may have occurred during shipment. If any part is damaged or missing, do not attempt to use the product. Please contact the Draper Helpline; contact details can be found at the back of this manual.

### Tools required:

- 10, 13 and 14mm wrench or sockets for fixing nuts and bolts.
- During assembly do not tighten bolts until all components are aligned properly, then tighten fully.
- **Important:** for ease of use the swivelling castors must be fitted to the same end as the push bar.



## Maintenance and Disposal

- Oil the castors periodically with a light oil.
- Clean with a damp cloth. **DO NOT** use solvent based cleaners.
- At the end of its working life, dispose of the product responsibly and in line with local regulations. Recycle where possible.
