- Ensure that the workbench is fully assembled, opened and tightened before use, with the folding braces locked in place.
- Ensure that the workbench is positioned on firm and level ground while it is in use.

- **DO NOT** use the workbench on slippery or wet surfaces.
- **DO NOT** climb or stand on the workbench.
- **DO NOT** exceed the rated weight limit.
- **DO NOT** store heavy loads on the workbench for extended periods.
- Position the workpiece so that the weight is evenly distributed and does not overbalance the workbench.
- **NEVER** clamp or mount tools to the workbench.
- **DO NOT** expose the product to rain or wet environments.
- Take care when lifting or moving the workbench.
- Store the workbench in a clean and dry location, out of direct sunlight and out of reach of children.



CAUTION!
DO NOT overtighten the clamps.

Assembly Instructions

Important: Before assembling this product, read and understand all the safety instructions listed in this manual.

Note: **DO NOT** fully tighten the fixings until assembly is complete.

Step 1

- Connect the crossbars (4) to the leg frames (5) using the M6 bolts (9), washers (13) and M6 nuts (10).

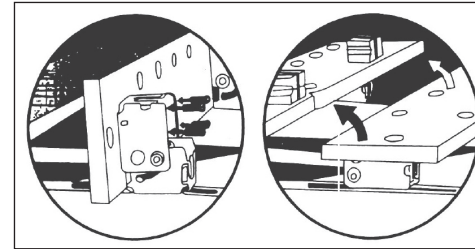

Step 2

- Connect the worktops (1) to the slide bases (2) using the wood screws (8) – Fig. 1.

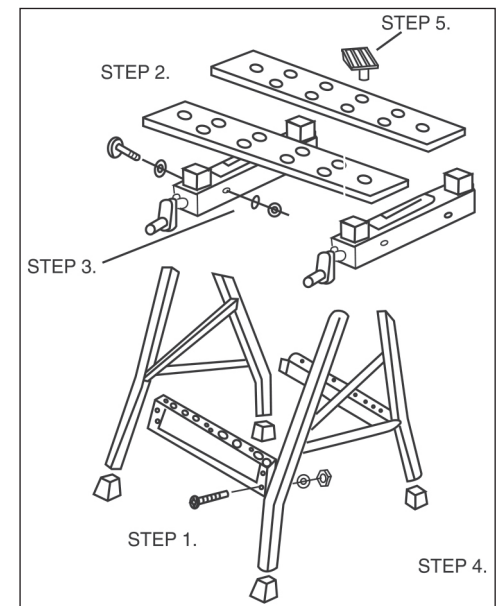

Step 3

1. Fit the leg frames (5) into the slide bases (2) by aligning the holes in the slide base with the holes in the leg frame.
2. Insert the M8 bolts (3) and 8mm washer (7) from outside of the base. Then attach further 8mm washers (7) and 8mm nuts (11) from inside.
3. Use the supplied spanner (14) to tighten the bolts.

Step 4

- Attach the plastic feet (6) to the legs (5). Attach each foot with the longest side at the outer corner, as indicated by the arrow inside.

Step 5

- Fix the chocks (12) to the most suitable holes in the worktops (1).
