
- Use adequate manpower when assembling and moving this unit. Failure to do so may cause personal injury or product damage.

- 4 Feet x45 Wooden top x2
- 6 Support rail x2

# 7. UNPACKING & CHECKING

#### 7.1 PACKAGING

Carefully remove all components from the packaging and examine it for any sign of damage that may have happened during shipping. Lay the contents out and check them against the parts shown below. If any part is damaged or missing; please contact the Draper Helpline (the telephone number appears on the Title page) and do not attempt to use the workbench.

The packaging material should be retained at least during the guarantee period: in case the machine needs to be returned for repair.


Warning! Some of the packaging materials used may be harmful to children. Do not leave any of these materials in the reach of children.

If any of the packaging is to be thrown away, make sure they are disposed of correctly; according to local regulations.


# 8. PREPARING THE WORKBENCH

### 8.1 ASSEMBLY - FIGS. 1 - 5


Attach the rubber feet 4 to the base of each support rail 1.




Locate the plug from the cross rail ② into the slot of the support rail ①. Using a rubber mallet, gently tap the plug down so it is secure. Repeat this for both ends of the workbench.



Locate the long cross rail ③ plug into the slot of the support rail ① again using a soft mallet tap the plug so it is secure.



Secure the support rail (6) between the cross rail (3) on both sides using the nuts and bolts provided.



Insert the wooden top and shelf (ensuring you do not trap fingers) into the recess in the rails.
