- Attach feet (Fig. 1).
- Connect folding leg (Fig. 2).
- Slide extending arm.
- Screw in adjustment handle.
- Attach roller head (Fig. 3).

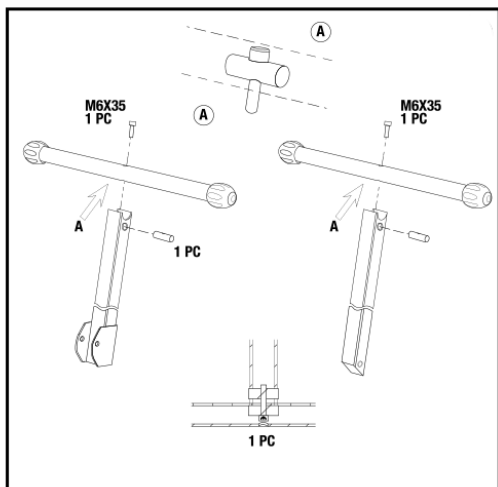

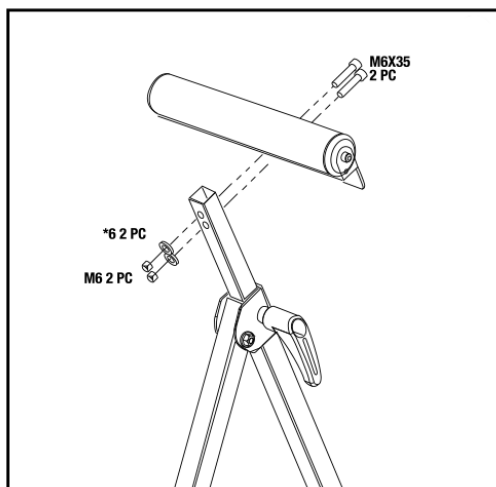

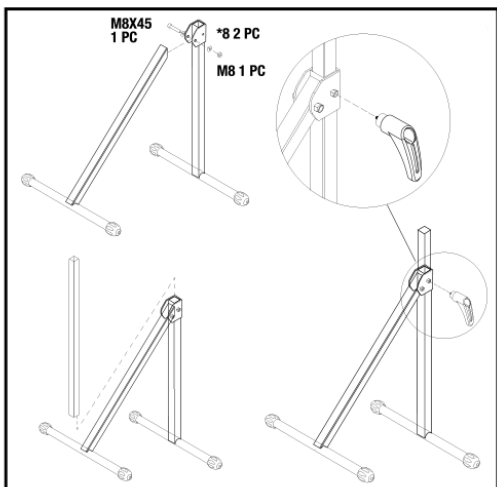
