
- DO NOT turn the light on when it is being charged.
- DO NOT shine the light directly into eyes.
- · DO NOT allow children to use the light.
- Recharge indoors only using a standard 230V electrical outlet.
- · DO NOT expose to rain.
- DO NOT handle or move the light whilst it is being charged.
- **DO NOT** leave battery in a discharged state, recharge battery immediately.
- DO NOT overcharge the light, recharge no more than 12 hours continuously.
- **DO NOT** drop the light as this can damage and shorten its life span.



WARNING! To reduce the risk of burns or fire:

- DO NOT attempt to open, disassemble, modify or service the light.
- DO NOT crush, puncture, short external contacts or dispose of in fire or water.
- DO NOT expose to temperatures above 50°C.
- DO NOT use this product if the casing is damaged in any way or if there is evidence of battery leakage.



5. Charging The Light




WARNING!

- Ensure the ON/OFF button 4 is in the 'OFF' position before charging.
- · The light must be charged before use.
- 1. Press the cable storage release button (5) to release the charging port cover (6).
- 2. Then insert the USB cable 11 Type-C connector end into the charging port 8.
- Connect the USB-A connector end into a suitable 230V charger (not supplied).
 - The 'RED' indicator light will come on when charging.
 - The 'GREEN' indicator light will come on when fully charged.
- 4. Disconnect the charger from the light as soon as fully charged.



6. Operation

- 1. Press the ON/OFF button 4 to switch the light on.
- 2. Press the button to cycle through the beam modes:
- Always switch off when not in use.




7. USB Power Output

Use the USB power output port 9 as a power bank to charge other portable devices.

Maintenance, Storage and Disposal
